Category:Slamdance Competition winnersQ: Firewall best practices for deploying to server with potential concerns I'm deploying my site to a Linode instance (with a Linode Loadbalancer) and I was wondering if there were any best practices regarding the firewall. My website's information is stored in MySQL. MySQL is listening on port 3306. As far as I understand it, I need to make sure that only traffic from port 3306 and localhost will be able to access my database. However, if I make my-database.db.example.com point to my Linode, and localhost is set to 192.168.1.104, then anyone from the Internet can access my database. Do I need to make sure I don't give out the Linode's IP address, or do I need to create a subnet on my Linode for the mySQL server? (And if so, is there any way to get the subnet name from the Linode so I can configure the firewall on the Linode?) Also, how do I make sure that no one gets to access my database from the Internet other than through the same port MySQL is listening on? A: You should make sure that no one gets to access your database from the Internet other than through the same port MySQL is listening on. For that, you need to connect the instance's firewall to the external firewall. That means that you set MySQL up on the Linode and then you configure your firewall to only allow TCP traffic from that IP address to that port. You would not be able to specify a subnet unless you were given one. If you have a dedicated, you should be able to get the subnet from the Linode itself. How to make your own XChat window more attractive How can I make my own XChat window more attractive, especially the text, it's very small and no matter how much I zoom in, the text is still too small to read? Here is what my window looks like currently: A: Use a different font You can set the font in the preferences using the Settings -> Interface -> Fonts section. There are some fonts included in Ubuntu, but I prefer to use Ubuntu font for most of my interface. There are other free fonts out there that you might want to try. I have to agree that the default one is really small. Use a different chat window layout This might be worth it, but I haven't tested it yet. If you are interested, there is a project called XChat2 at GitHub. It looks interesting and is still being actively developed, but is not complete yet (it should be soon, I hope). Another alternative is to use the improved XChat2 window that goes back to the good old days. Check this out: A: If you are using Linux Mint, go to Settings > Software Sources > Other Software and tick the box for "Show the Linux Mint Menu" to show the Mint Menu. Once you've checked that box, restart XChat. This will show the menu to change the font, text size, and other XChat settings. Here's what mine looks like. EDIT: Since the Mint Menu is no longer included in Linux Mint 16, I think the workaround is to use the Software Center. In the Software Center, click the "Edit" button in the top right corner, then the "Software Sources". Tick the box for "Show the Mint Menu". Click the "Reload" button and restart XChat.
